- Discussed the box top program, and need to turn in Campbell's labels by December because they are ending that program.
- Discussed using Scrip certificates for the Sunshine Fund; Need someone to centralize and guidelines. Ms. Walter is willing to help.
- Discussed upkeep of the school web site and possibility of paying someone through the marketing budget; Monica Seimer is willing and able to do the work (as part of her job). She would have a cut-off or day she'll be doing updates

Motion to adjourn was made by Mrs. Dean. Seconded by Katie Lake. Motion Passed.
