## 2015 Lotto Update

To date we have sold **1254 Lotto Tickets**  
For a total of **\$25,080**  
\$10,000 of which will get paid out to winners this year

Even though the students will not receive their March Carnival Day b/c at least 1500 tickets have not been sold. These tickets were sold and money collected over approximately 60 days which is a **TREMENDOUS ACCOMPLISHMENT** and something that the **PARISH & SCHOOL SHOULD PROUD and APPLAUDED FOR!!** Several families are receiving quite a bit of Out of Uniform Passes, Homework Passes, Free Lunch, Scrip Gift Certificates, etc.

*The money from the Lotto will be put towards the resurfacing of the Parking lot hopefully to happen this summer!*

We had 121 school families who took part in the selling of the Lotto tickets along with several parish families.
