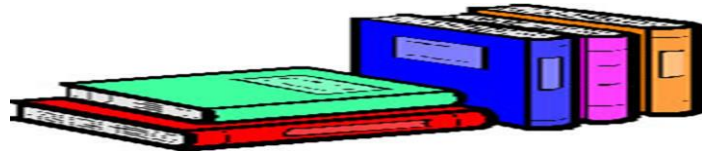

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A MESSAGE FROM MRS. HERRMANN

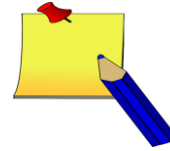
I hope everybody had a great four day week! I am hoping that it will start to cool down soon! I wanted to give a few reminders: please do not drop off students at school before 8:20; this is when teachers will be in their rooms. Also, please pull into the school parking lot at dismissal time for your children to meet you. Once students are dismissed, it is only a 5-7 minutes process for all cars to clear the parking lot. If students are walking to Park Ave. to be picked up, there is no supervision and it is not safe.

Today, was our first Spanish session and we had a great number of kids who signed up for the class. When students arrive for Spanish, please enter through the glass doors to the side of the main entrance of the Junior High building and proceed to the Adult Enrichment Room. These doors will be unlocked for students to enter. There will be a total of three, ten week sessions this school year. These sessions are taught by Ms. Davis who teaches Spanish at several local Catholic grade schools. Please keep an eye out for registrations for the second session.
