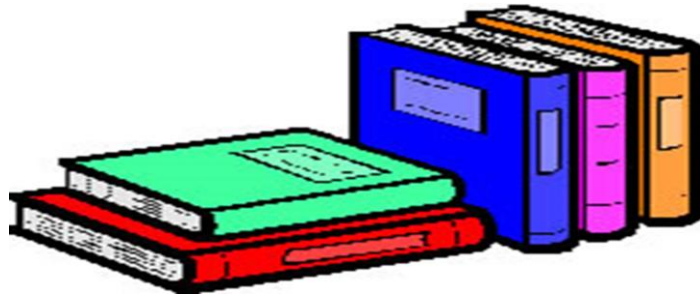

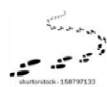

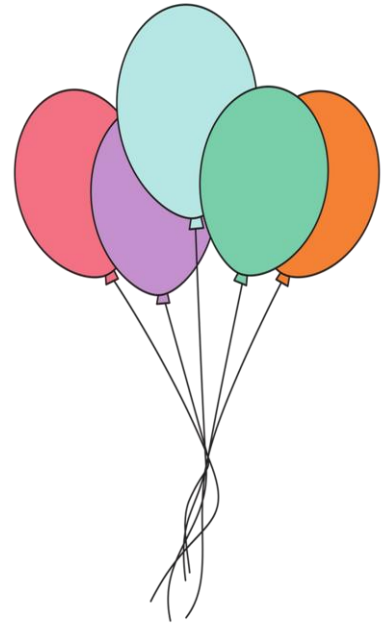
Come for the fun!
