Principal's Report – Nicole Herrmann

- Accelerated Math: Used a couple years ago, but it has changed and need professional development – use AR budget
- Preschool will be starting; 13 3 year olds; 18 4 year olds; 14 Pre-K
- Mrs. Herrmann has an open door policy; Is listening and learning

Treasurer Report: Shelley Haverbusch

- Shelley has met with Mike Newton and he needs some changes to the budget; Shelley explained the reasons and some of the details
- Ms. Walter made a motion to have the PTC Board revise the budget, second by Micki Hines. Motion carried.

Walk-A-Thon: Kelly Best

- Goal this year is \$17000; Event is on September 28
- No grand prize yet; Need new ideas
- Using #SJB to promote it
- Get t-shirt and out-of-uniform passes; Cash prizes and/or scrip; Prizes for individuals and classes
- Possibly rubber band bracelets
- This is the last year for Kelly leading the WAT
- 2 turn-in days on Thursdays ahead of event; If \$8000 is raised by the second one, then we'll have Lindsey's Shaved Ice on WAT day
- Will use WeShare to accept online donations despite possible processing fee

- Bleeding Control Kits:
 - o Kelly Besl recommended that we get Bleeding Control Kits and place them at all the locations we have Automated External Defibrillators; It was agreed that this could be paid for from the PTC safety budget
 - o Kelly also discussed the "Stop the Bleed" clinic that UC Medical Center offers. She will coordinate scheduling this for the faculty and possibly a second session for parents
- 8th Grade Golf Outing: Becky Lipp asked for the \$100 hole sponsor donation from PTC (budgeted) and also for spirit-wear for their basket raffle
- Caring Neighbors program: Mrs. Herrmann has been in contact with Remke; Remke would like to be more involved with our school, like they are with Harrison schools; They are offering programs such as Honor Roll treats, their pumpkin contest and other discounts
- Keeneland Bus Trip is in the works for next spring
- Toy and Clothing Sale is cancelled
- Ms. Walter is still collecting bottle caps to be used towards a picnic table; will be asking for \$\$ in the future
- Amy Enginger talked about the 8th grade project of collecting clothes and old uniforms to send to El Salvador and the possibility of getting a suitcase donated or purchased. It was mentioned that this aligned with the school's accreditation theme of "Clothe the naked" this year.
