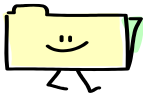

Second Step is to Complete Background & Training through SafeParish

*If you have completed a background check through the old system, VIRTUS, no new background check will be required.

Finally, once you have been approved through SafeParish you will be required to keep up with your quarterly training videos.

UNMASKED & UNVACCINATED

COVID-19 +

3 FT MINIMUM

THE STUDENT WHO IS UNMASKED **AND** IS UNVACCINATED, AND IS A CLOSE CONTACT OF A STUDENT WHO IS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 **WILL NEED** TO QUARANTINE.

MASKED VACCINATED OR UNVACCINATED

COVID-19 +

3 FT MINIMUM

THE STUDENT WHO IS MASKED, REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS, AND IS A CLOSE CONTACT OF A STUDENT WHO IS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 WHO IS ALSO MASKED, WOULD **NOT** NEED TO QUARANTINE.

MASKED & UNVACCINATED

COVID-19 +

3 FT MINIMUM

THE STUDENT WHO IS MASKED **AND** IS UNVACCINATED, AND IS A CLOSE CONTACT OF A STUDENT WHO IS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 AND IS UNMASKED, WOULD **NOT** NEED TO QUARANTINE.

UNMASKED & VACCINATED

COVID-19 +

3 FT MINIMUM

THE STUDENT WHO IS UNMASKED **AND** IS VACCINATED, AND IS A CLOSE CONTACT OF A STUDENT WHO IS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19, WOULD **NOT** NEED TO QUARANTINE.

A POSITIVE CASE OF COVID-19 WILL NEED TO ISOLATE REGARDLESS OF THEIR MASK USAGE OR VACCINATION STATUS.
