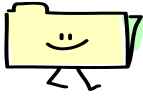

I wanted to give an update regarding COVID-19. As of today, we have not had any positive student or staff cases at St. John's since school started. We are still recommending that masks are worn at school. If a student is exposed while wearing a mask or is vaccinated (either wearing a mask or not) they will not have to quarantine. We hope this will greatly reduce the number of students who will have to quarantine if they are exposed at school. Our goal is to keep our students healthy and in school. If the number of positive student/staff cases begins to increase, a temporary mask mandate may be put into place at St. John's. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
