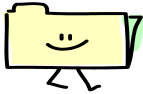

## A MESSAGE FROM MRS. HERRMANN

As we enter January, we are preparing for registration for the 2021-2022 school year. Unfortunately, due to Covid, we will not be having our traditional Open House at the end of the month. Instead we will be hosting private tours and virtual information sessions for families interested in attending St. John's.
