PTC Zoom Meeting

Meeting was called to order 7:00pm, followed by opening prayer

Prior Minutes

March minutes - Motion to approve by Ms Walter, second by Ms Dean.

Principal's Report: Mrs. Herrmann

- Thank you to the PTC board for the last 2 years of service (especially Shelly for staying on a little longer).
- Thank you to the teachers - it has been a fantastic year despite the limitations.
- We have had no new COVID cases since last meeting.
- The 21/22 school year will still probably have some restrictions; not sure exactly what it will look like just yet.
- A parishioner gave a donation for a scholarship that will begin this year. It is for 2 current 5th graders (a boy and a girl); they will get \$500 for their 6th through 8th grade years. Students will have to do 2 essays and their grades will be looked at for scholarship.
- 2nd graders will be making their First Communion over the next few weekends; keep them in your prayers.
- 5 more weeks of school; all end of the year events are being planned - we are excited to be doing things a little more normally this year.
- Last day of school is May 19th.
- We received a government grant to do a summer program; students will be identified and invited by their teachers to participate in it; it will provide extra help to those students who would benefit; families would get a letter from school; it is not mandatory.

Treasurer Report: Shelley Haverbusch

- Who is in charge of 1st reconciliation and communion reception next year?

- Awards dinner is May 13th; scholarship winners will be notified at that dinner - Shelly will need the names
- We have ~\$2200 leftover from CSW and student/teacher appreciation that we can use.
- \$61,900 currently in account; confirmation budget increased to \$100; 8th grade dinner decreased from \$1500 to \$500; Wire family budget can be removed for next year as well as buses to new church for first school mass.

Current Business:

- Micki Hines working on things for teacher appreciation week in May.
- Ice Cream will be given out at Relay for Life on May 14th; popsicles will be sold at Relay for Life as well; Amy Bibee can get a discount at Kroger for ice cream; get vanilla and chocolate flavors and sprinkles and chocolate syrup for toppings? be aware of peanut/other allergies. budget is \$500
- Micki Hines is working with Jessica in the rectory on school blurb in bulletin; JESSICA is on board, everything is set up and ready; hoping to start a week or two before school starts next year.
- Lost and Found will be in the parking lot at the end of year - will try to get pictures of stuff on FB page and in J. J.
- Zoom meetings will be a continuing conversation; offer Zoom every time but have them in person every other?
- Amy Bibee suggests having a parent rep for each grade/homeroom attend each meeting and report back to class.
- How do we boost attendance/participation? Incentives? Think about this.
- Basketball hoops are going to cost a bit more than originally thought; \$1500 for the hoop then \$1800 for installation; Maybe for now we could get a few portable ones donated, not ideal but will do until we figure out money for permanent ones; the previous ones were portable and there wasn't an issue with them falling over, the issue was older kids hanging on the rims; does anyone have one they would like to donate?
- All attendants approved to give the money (\$2000) for the permanent hoops now and hopefully will get more in the future.
- PTC giving \$2500 for school website was approved by all attendants.
- New PTC Board voted in:
 - Micki Hines for President
 - Melissa Wood for V.P.
 - Carrie Howell for Secretary
 - Lindsay Bybee for Treasurer
- Melissa Wood - thank you so much to Shelly and Ms Walter - you have been so helpful to the board, couldn't have done this without you.

Other Business:

- Enrollment for next year is at 250 currently (this year was 262)
- Should we do signs for 8th graders again? take 8th grade dinner money and use it for signs?
- What about welcome signs for new families? There is a budget for "Welcome Bags" of \$1000; usually only use ~\$600; signs cost about ~\$7 each.
- Mrs. Ziegler would like PTC to pay for skates in PE; take \$750 from A.R. budget that hasn't been used and \$400 from Quarterly Awards; that will cover it and this would be just a one time things for this year; motion was approved by all in attendance.
- Aug 25th is first day of school; 1st PTC meeting will be Sept 16th.
